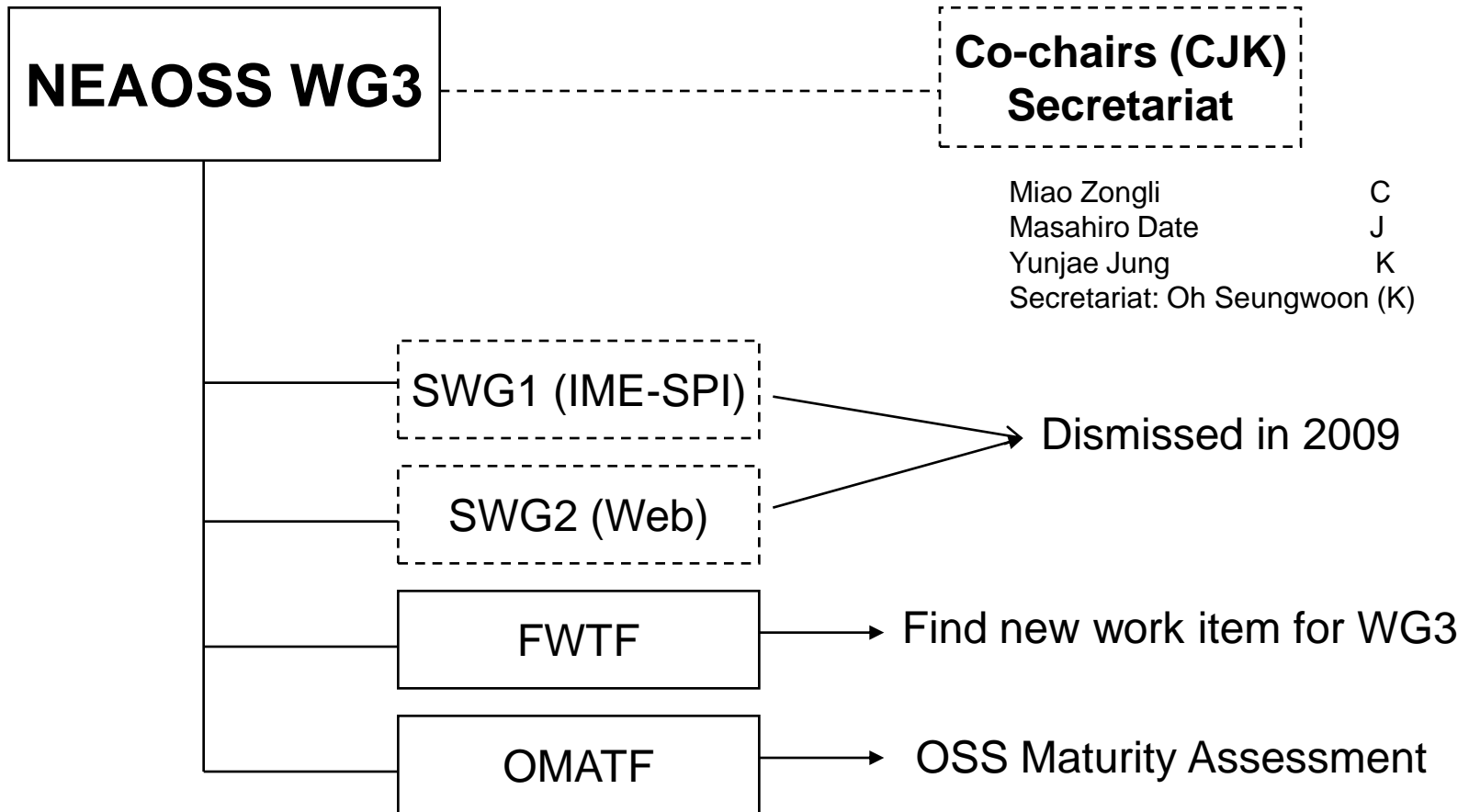
# Role of WG3

NEAOSS Forum formed

Open Source Software standardization and certification in July 2004

# WG3 structure and Officers

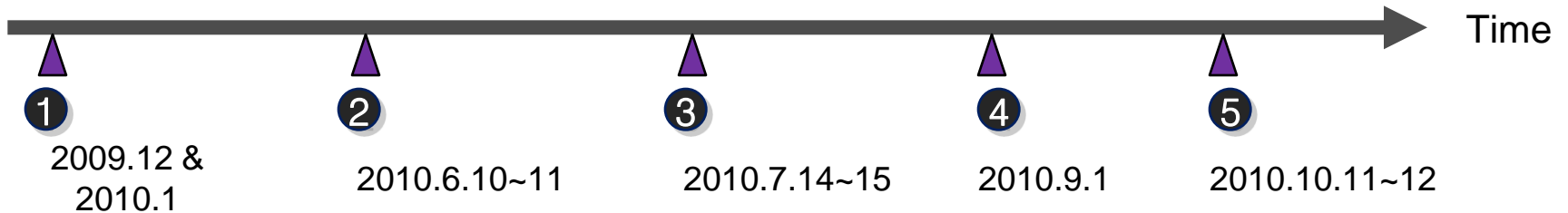


Note: All activities/decisions are per NEAOSS WG3 directives

# Agreement of 8<sup>th</sup> NEA OSS Forum

- WG3 published “Specifications for an IM Engine Service Provider Interface (WG3 WR00001),” “Report on Web Interoperability Discrepancies (WG3 TR00003),” and “Solutions for Web Interoperability Discrepancies (WG3 TR00004)” in 2008 as deliverables in the WG3’s first projects.
- After publication of the above deliverables, WG3 closed out its SWG1 and SWG2 at its 12th meeting in Tokyo.
- For the opening of the next project , the Chairman’s Statement at the 7th Forum in Wuxi stated that WG3 would establish a “Future Work Task Force.” In 2009, the Future Work Task Force was set up and held three meetings prior to this 8th Forum. **The Task Force has discussed several candidate projects. But further discussion is necessary before making final decisions.**

# Achievement of WG3 in 2010

- 1) Setup OSS Maturity Assessment Task Force (OMATF) to work on “OSS assessment” on 15<sup>th</sup> July 2010, WG3 13<sup>th</sup> meeting ,Beijing.

**Objective:** providing OSS maturity information under common criteria for stakeholders to choose more suitable OSS.

# Achievement of WG3 in 2010

- 2) OSS categorization and assessment methodology were studied, and agreement had been reached among CJK.

Based on the agreements,

- Over 300 OSSs were selected for first stage assessment.
- Assessment tasks have been allocated to each MB of CJK

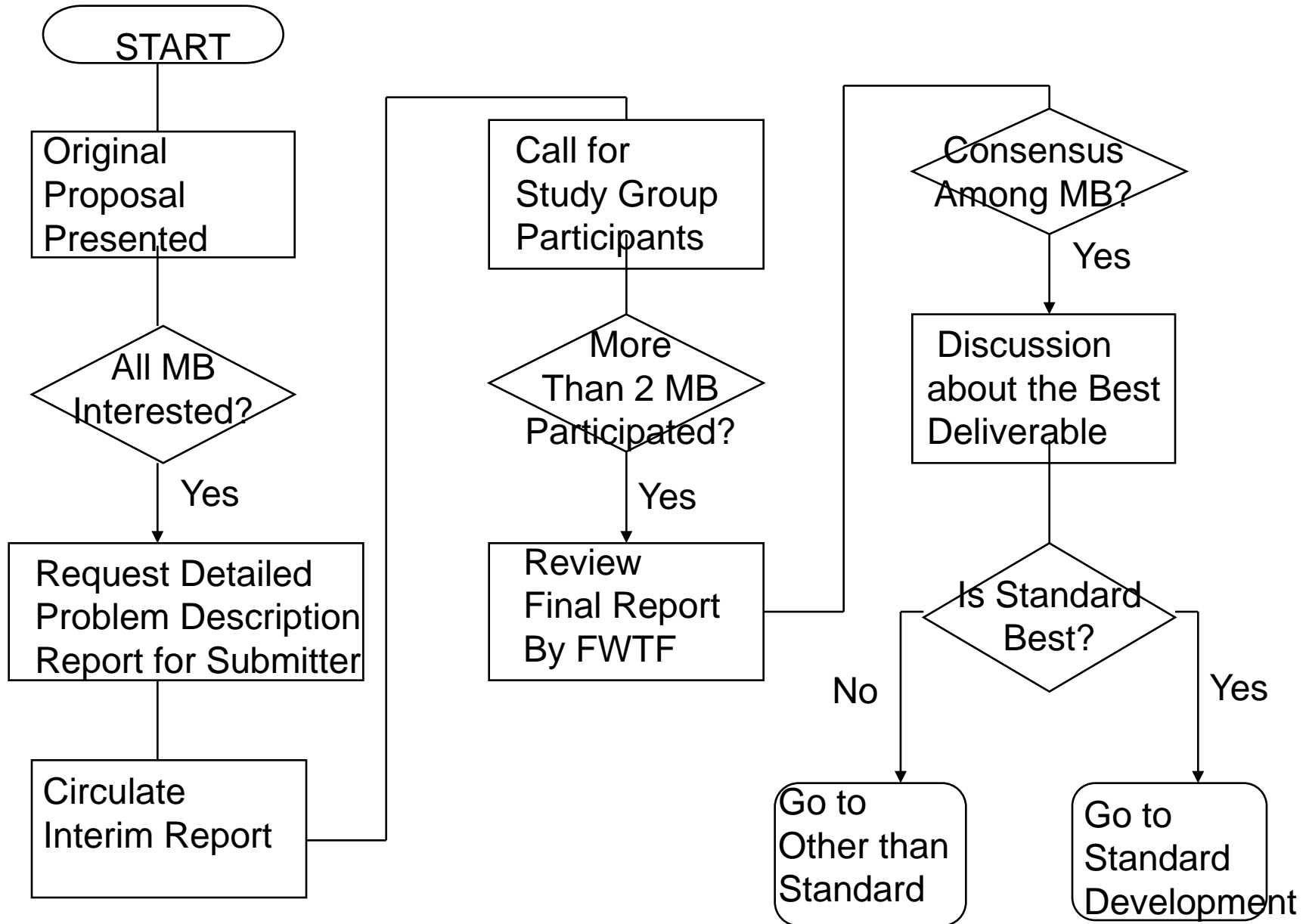
# Achievement of WG3 in 2010

- 3) 102 OSSs has been accessed.
  - Service Access and Delivery
  - Component Technology
  - Security
  - Interface and Integration
  - Platform and Infrastructure
